

Rosetrees Trust Conflict of Interest Guidelines

Please inform us of any potential conflicts of interest (COI) that would prevent you from reviewing the application. Please see below for potential examples of COIs.

- Have co-authored papers or grants within the last 5 years with the principal applicant, the co-applicants or collaborators.
- Are directly involved in the work that the applicant proposes and/or have contributed to the application.
- Currently collaborating or have recently collaborated with the applicant (within the last two years).
- Have submitted an application to the same round for which you are being asked to provide a review.
- Have been approached and agreed to be a member of a committee connected with the research project (for example an advisory group or steering committee).
- Are involved in work that could directly compete with the work that the applicant proposes in their application; or have a commercial or financial interest. For example, if you are part of an organisation that may benefit financially, directly or indirectly, from any decision made.
